To establish a policy to cover drinks and food in the public areas of the library

PUBLIC AREA FOOD AND DRINK POLICY Glendora Public Library

This policy covers consumption of food and drink in all public areas of the library. Exceptions may include events held in meeting rooms, special events in the library, and/or other circumstances as approved by the Library Director or designee prior to the event.

Food and drink are allowed in the library on a limited basis with the following restrictions:

	with sipper tops, bottled water)	
	Vending machine type snacks (e.g. candy, cookies, crackers, nuts, chips) in a wrapper, bag or container.	
NOT ALLOWED:	Open drinks	

Alcohol
Ice Cream/yogurt

Restaurant Food (including fast food meals such as hamburgers,

fries, salads, tacos, burritos, pizza, etc.)

Sandwiches

ALLOWED:

Anything requiring one or more utensils, such as soup, salads, etc.

Beverages in covered containers (e.g. cans, cups with a top, bottles

No food or drink is allowed around any of the Library's public computer equipment. Food and drink privileges, use of library rooms, facility, and/or resources may be suspended if policy is abused.
