- Sharps and pharmaceuticals accepted at San Dimas Sheriff's Station Drop Off Box, 270 S. Walnut Ave., San Dimas
- Pharmaceuticals, only, accepted at Glendora Police Dept., 150 S. Glendora Ave.
- Household paint accepted at Dunn-Edwards, 630 S. Grand Ave., Glendora (626) 963-4825. Call for store hours—please do not leave any items if store is closed.
- Household batteries and household paint are accepted at Mission ACE Hardware, 531 S. Glendora Ave., Glendora (626) 914-7980. Paint should be in the original, sealed container and the label must be legible. Dried up paint will not be accepted and may be placed in the trash. No commercial or industrial products will be accepted. Call Mission ACE Hardware for store hours—please do not leave any items if store is closed.
- Electronic waste such as TV's (working or non working) , computers and computer accessories are accepted at both Glendora Goodwill Stores located at 1936 E. Route 66 (626-335-4468) and 526 W. Foothill Blvd. (626-610-0949). Label TV's and computers as "E-Waste."

How to Prepare. . .

Bring the items you wish to dispose of in a sturdy box preferably in their original, labeled containers.

Do not EVER mix products together.

There is a limit of 15 gallons or 125 pounds per vehicle.

Be prepared to leave your containers.

WHAT YOU CAN BRING TO A HHW COLLECTION:

Motor oil, oil filters, brake fluid, antifreeze,

Paint, paint thinner, turpentine, aerosol cans

Cleaning products

All household batteries and car batteries

Pool and garden chemicals

Electronic devices such as computers, monitors, printers and printer cartridges, keyboards, computer mouse, TV's, radios, microwaves, telephones, cell phones, electronic toys, video games, etc.

Mercury containing devices such as thermometers and thermostats

Unwanted or expired pharmaceuticals

Sharps and needles (Must be transported in approved sharps containers. Sharps containers are available at Glendora City Hall, Planning Dept., for \$1.00)

Fluorescent tubes, bulbs and other mercury containing lamps

Any type of light bulbs will be accepted, including halogen

Propane tanks (empty or filled)

Old or unusable gasoline

Asbestos pipe (double wrap in plastic)

Household cooking oil and grease (not from businesses)

WHAT YOU CANNOT BRING TO A HHW COLLECTION:

Explosives, ammunition

Radioactive materials

Trash or old tires

Business waste

White goods (stoves, refrigerators, etc.) or furniture

PERMANENT HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION CENTERS:

The City of Los Angeles operates six permanent Household Hazardous Waste collection centers.
